Leader of the Council, Ronnie Round, Cllr Larry Nolan (Portfolio Member for Education), Sheena Ramsey (Chief Executive, KMBC) and Damian Allen, Director of Children's Services began the day by broadcasting welcome address, context and objectives of the event.

Delegates took part in a series of presentations and workshops on a range of themes including 21st Century Learning Environments, Collaborative Working, Raising Attainment and Integrating Children's Services.
