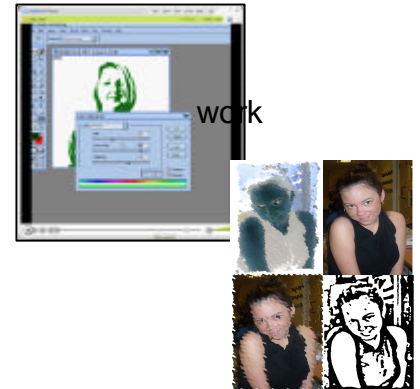

- ✍ To use Photoshop to manipulate images to support GCSE work
- ✍ To use layering techniques using graphics software
- ✍ To understand the benefits of using ICT to support art work
- ✍ To become familiar with techniques such as scanning



BRIEF

The aim of this project is to enable students to produce Andy Warhol (American Pop Artist, 1928-1987) style images using photographs of themselves using package Adobe Photoshop.

DESCRIPTION

Using a series of interactive training videos developed by the Centres, students and teachers have been able to brush up their Photoshop skills. The videos lead learners through a series of on screen activities. These resources are used by both staff and pupils giving them the opportunity to improve their skills along with teaching them new techniques that can then be put into practise as part of their GCSE coursework portfolio.

The work that has been produced as part of this project have been included in student's portfolios. The project has been part of a complete process, from design and drawing to computer manipulation. Some of the work is displayed on the walls in the classroom.
