### LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- To ensure that front line staff across Education and Children and Family services were clear about the vision and understand the roles they play in the delivery of these services.

### BRIEF

The Children's Bill brings about some major changes of how services for children and young people are delivered. Working with Huyton Creative Learning Centre, Maxine Froggatt (Assistant Director, DELL) and Moya Sutton (Assistant Director, Children and Families) wanted to get the change in roles across to deliver a common message using an accessible media. The task, to deliver a DVD to promote this message cross council.



### DESCRIPTION

To get the message across the two services worked closely with Huyton Creative Learning Centre to produce a DVD using the studio facilities. The DVD was recorded, edited and duplicated at the centre; the outcome 'Integrating services for Children and Young People – Creating the Dream Team' which was shown at all team meetings across the Council. This DVD will also form part of the information portfolio for the service.

Alongside providing information about the process, the DVD demonstrated the support of senior executives for the integration of services and will enable many people to put names to faces within the structure.

Commenting on the finished product at the launch event, Maxine and Moya said "What they have achieved is nothing short of amazing".

### OUTCOMES/EVALUATION
