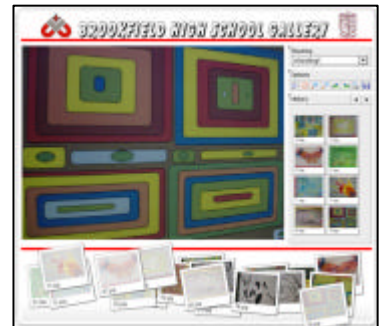
LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- ✍ To produce an interactive gallery to display pupils work
- ✍ To provide an archive of work as reference materials for current pupils
- ✍ To provide pupils with an opportunity to show others there work
- ✍ Appropriate use of ICT – from creation to innovation



BRIEF

This programme is the first phase of a long term strategy to support art, graphics and textiles from Years 7 – 11. The CLCs have supported Jane Lawton (Head of Graphics) by using eLearning strategies to promote the excellent work designed by pupils from a wide range of abilities.



DESCRIPTION

An interactive gallery has been produced to display pupils work at the school. This gallery is accessible via the CLCs Intranet and give pupils the opportunity to showcase their work. Once complete and approved, the designs are scanned and imported into the gallery, providing an archive of work for Key Stage Three. As well as providing a 21st Century media to display designs, the gallery also provides teachers with a valuable record of pupils work. Since this archive is constantly evolving, classes are able to browse similar projects to scope a range of ideas and level of abilities. More importantly, it is a gallery that never closes, accessible 24/7.

OUTCOMES/EVALUATION

This project has been well received by both pupils and teachers and is really only in it's infancy, but already has been used by a cluster of primary schools on recent visits to the Centres.
