### **BRIEF**

The Knowsley Learning Partnership is a representative group made up of Chief Officers, Councillors and community representatives. These meetings enable the CLCs to promote it's activities across the centres and support existing and developing programmes taking place a cross the Council.

### **DESCRIPTION**

The Executive held their quarterly meeting at the Kirkby City Learning Centre. A wide range of partners attended including the Council members and officers, representatives from each of the 5 Thematic Partnerships, Government Office North West, Merseyside Police, Knowsley Council for Voluntary Services, Knowsley's Community Empowerment Network and Mersey Travel.

The development of the City Learning Centres had been mentioned at an earlier meeting of the Executive and by holding the meeting at Kirkby CLC, it provided the opportunity for the Knowsley Partnership Executive members to visit a City Learning Centre.
