LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- ✍ For students to become familiar with 21st Century available to support teaching and learning
- ✍ To develop PE/ICT resources to support Key Stage 4 PE



BRIEF

A group of 50 Year One PE students from LJMU visited Kirkby CLC for their first taste of future schooling. The students were given the opportunity to sample the technologies available including performance analysis using the Performance Centre and Digital Studio.

DESCRIPTION

During their visit, students were given the opportunity to try out some of the interactive curriculum resources developed by the Centre, the VCampus applied GCSE eLearning materials and have an opportunity to explore the Knowsley Learning Place.

The students also took part in a video conferencing activity with a group of Inclusion pupils who are working on an interactive ICT course.

This introductory session was aimed at giving the students an opportunity to become familiar with the technology that is available within the CLCs, so that once they begin teaching practice they are well placed to exploit the technology that is available to them.

OUTCOMES/EVALUATION

Following this visit, a group of students created web based PE resources to support Key Stage Four at the Centre beginning 31st March 2003. These resources are now available through the KLP. The materials being developed included sporting techniques such as swimming, gymnastics, etc. Students worked in partnership with the Resource Development Team at the Centre and Brookfield PE staff and students.
