### LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- To have raised awareness on internet safety with Year 6 pupils.
- To have run the ThinkuKnow education resource presentation.
- To have provided a parent session to raise awareness on the potential risk associated with internet use.



### BRIEF

The brief of this work is to create a pilot esafety awareness session that can be offered to all schools in Knowsley as part of the City Learning Centre resource activities or via outreach programs. The sessions will be built around the CEOP (Child Exploitation & Online Protection Centre) ThinkuKnow education resource presentation.

### DESCRIPTION

In February 2007 the CLC Learning Assistants attended a borough wide training session on how to provide the CEOP (Child Exploitation & Online Protection Centre) ThinkuKnow education resource. This presentation is shown to children and young people to raise awareness on the dangers on using online communications such as the internet and mobile phones.

After the training session we decided that CLC's could offer the ThinkuKnow presentation as either a CLC activity or an out reach activity in schools.

We setup a pilot session with year 6 Malvern Primary School. We provided two sessions for the school, one for parents and one for the year 6 pupils. The parent's session was to raise awareness with the parents about the possible dangers of the internet but to also allow the parents to see the content of the presentation.

Both sessions were well attended and feedback was very positive.

### OUTCOMES/EVALUATION

The sessions were very well attended. The parent's session attracted 23 parents with the following feedback:
